Hotham Park Discovery Garden is located within Hotham Park, which is near the centre of Bognor Regis. It is a walled garden in the corner of the park, near the entrance adjacent to Edward Bryant School, off London Road.

The area has been renovated to enhance opportunities for outdoor learning.
